An online resource for professionals who serve family caregivers

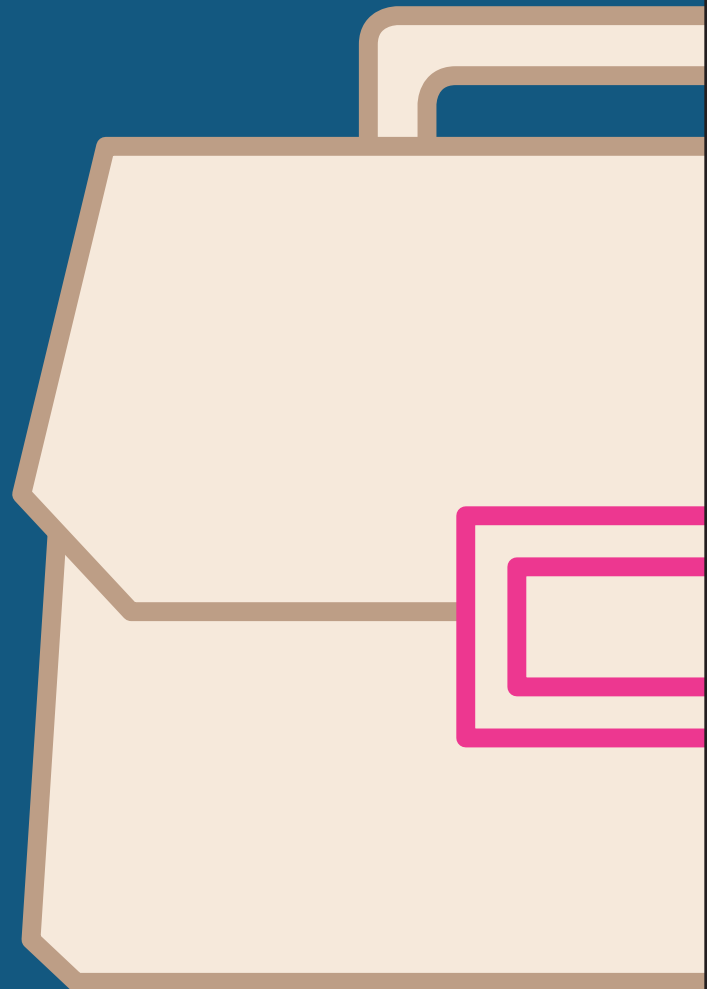
