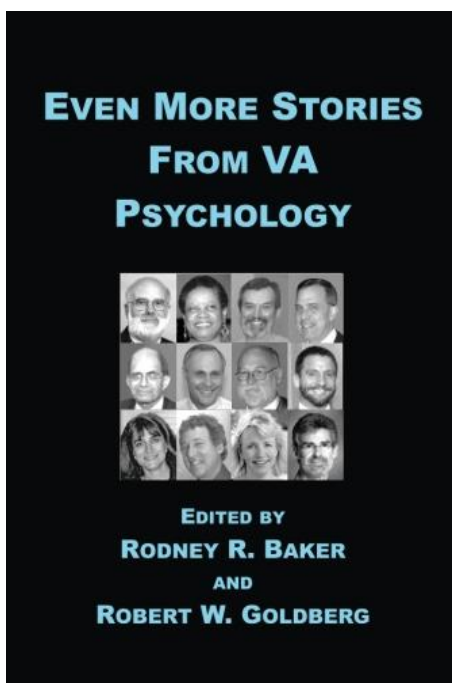


Even More Stories From VA Psychology

Even More Stories From VA Psychology follows the format of the first two stories books, *Stories From VA Psychology* and *More Stories From VA Psychology* (see bottom of page). Twelve former and current psychology leaders in the Veterans Administration/Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) describe their leadership careers and the people and events that shaped career decisions in working with veterans. Their stories expand the understanding of the formal history of VA psychologists in helping veterans over the years.

The careers of the chapter authors in this book collectively span 50 of the past 70 years of VA psychology history from 1946 through 2016. The authors discuss their formative VA or other training, trace their career development, and describe their clinical, training, research, administrative, and advocacy experiences. Their leadership stories in medical centers and in VA Central Office portray satisfying careers serving veterans and working with colleagues they admired and respected.

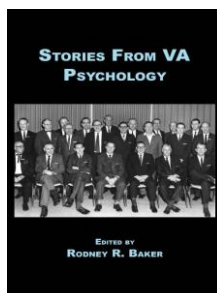

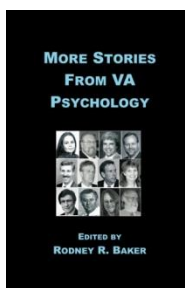
